

Privacy Policy

This policy describes the Personal Information we collect about you as a notifier/user and how this information is used. If you have any questions regarding this Policy, please contact info@feedmaterialsregister.eu.

The feed materials register is a website aimed at facilitating the notification of feed materials in application of article 24(6) of Regulation (EU) No 767/2009. It has been developed by EU organisations representing the following European feed business sectors (hereafter “Feed Materials Register owners”): AICV, AIJN, Brewers of Europe, CEEREAL, CEEV, CEFI, CEFIC, CEFS, COCERAL, COFALEC, Copa-Cogeca, EABA, EAPA, EBB, EDA, EFRA, EFFPA, EMFEMA, EMIDAS, EPA, ePure, EUCOLAIT, EUPPA, EUROMAISIER, EUROMALT, EUROPATAT, European Flour Millers, EUSALT, EUVEPRO, FEDIAF, FEDIOL, FEFAC, FEFANA, FERM, FoodDrinkEurope, IFFO, IMA-Europe, IPIFF, PROFEL, spiritsEUROPE and Starch Europe.

The practices of the Feed Materials Register owners with respect to data collected and used in connection with this website (the “Site”) are governed by this Privacy Policy.

1. General Data Protection Regulation

We respect the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) of 14 April 2016. The Feed Materials Register owners are the data controllers of this website.

Your access and use of this Site constitutes your agreement to this online privacy policy (“Privacy Policy”), which may be amended from time to time. The updated version is applicable and not the privacy policy in effect at the time the data was collected. Please regularly review our Privacy Policy. If at any time you do not agree or have objections to the Privacy Policy, you should immediately discontinue use of this Site.

2. Collection of Personal Information

Only the persons notifying feed materials are required to provide Personal Information regarding their name, email address and phone number on legal ground (Article 24(6) of Regulation (EU) No 767/2009).

Visitors of the Site are not required to provide any Personal Information on any area of the Site.

We consider that we have a legitimate interest in being able to contact you, as person notifying a feed material to the present register, by email and/or telephone in order to share with you our assessment of the correctness and lawfulness of your notification and there is no overriding prejudice to you by our use of your data in this way and for these purposes subject always to our carrying out appropriate checks.

3. Collection of Aggregate Information

We may also collect aggregate information and statistics (“Aggregate Information”) for the purpose of monitoring the Site usage in order to help us develop the Site and our services. These statistics are non-personally identifiable / anonymous information

about you and will therefore not include information that can be used to identify any individual.

When you, as person notifying a feed material, provide information on this Site, the Feed Materials Register Owners may consequently collect certain information about your computer. For example, we may log environmental variables, such as browser type, operating system, CPU speed, referring or exit webpages, and the Internet Protocol (IP) address of your computer. We do not match such information with any other information unless we have your consent.

4. Data collection and use

The Feed Materials Register Owners collect your Personal Information in order to:

- contact you and communicate with you;
- verify compliance with legal requirements of applicable laws, rules and regulations ;
- inform authorities in case the lawfulness of the application would be highly doubtful and might affect the integrity and reliability of the content of the Site.

The collection of Personal Information by the Feed Materials Register Owners will be limited to what is necessary for the purposes of collection. If the Personal Information is collected and processed for other purposes, your consent will be obtained before or at the time it is collected.

Feed Materials Register Owners will process or disclose your Personal Information only to authorities in case the lawfulness of the application would be highly doubtful and might affect the integrity and reliability of the content of the Site.

Upon request for deletion of an application, your Personal Information linked to this notification will be deleted as well. You may delete an application at any time by sending an email to info@feedmaterialsregister.eu.

The Feed Materials Register Owners keep your Personal Information only as long as needed for the purposes for which it is originally collected for legitimate purposes (such as legal compliance of the notifications). Your Personal Information will be deleted after a period of 5 years after your notification if we have not made use of them to contact you during this period of time. However, for notifications made before 4 October 2019 (date of entry into force of the present website), Personal Information will be kept until 4 October 2024.

The Feed Materials Register Owners do not sell, trade or transfer otherwise your Personal Information to any third parties other than to our agents, consultants and sub-contractors who assist us in running this Site and related services, and who are subject to security and confidentiality obligations, as well as to authorities where required for legitimate purposes. We only work with third parties that strictly comply with local data protection laws and the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679. The Feed Materials Register Owners will observe applicable law and take reasonable steps to ensure that any person or entity receiving or accessing your Personal Information for the purposes described here above are obligated to protect and keep secure the Personal Information.

5. Cookies

The Feed Materials Register Owners do not use cookies on this Site other than the first-party cookie “Google Analytics” which allows tracking visitor interactions, giving

us insights into this Site traffic and effectiveness. All data collected with the Google Analytics cookie is anonymous (such as browser information, date/time, demographic data, page views, etc.) or pseudonymous (such as IP address). These data are non-personally identifiable / anonymous information about you and will therefore not include information that can be used to identify any individual. You may set your browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. To enable or disable cookies, you may change your browser settings.

6. Data Security

We will keep your information confidential and secure and use it in accordance with our internal procedures covering the storage, access and disclosure of information, and all applicable laws. The Feed Materials Register Owners have implemented technical safeguards reasonably designed to protect your Personal Information.

The Feed Materials Register Owners will keep your Personal Information as accurate, complete and up-to-date as necessary for the purposes for which it is collected and processed. If any of the information that you have provided to us changes, for example if you change any of the Personal Information you provided in the notification form or if you wish to cancel your notification, please let us know by sending an email to info@feedmaterialsregister.eu.

7. Updating your Personal Information - Your Rights

You have the right to access the information we hold about you, to have any inaccurate information corrected and to object to/restrict the processing of your information. You also have the right to request an export of your data. To do so, please send your request to info@feedmaterialsregister.eu.
